Centre for Educational Psychology and Guidance (Centre de psychologie et

d'orientation scolaires - CPOS) and Life Stage Art and Education a.s.b.l have

developed a guidance programme with students in transition who have problems

integrating in the Luxembourgish school system.

"STOP & GO. Where do I stand - where do I want to go?", Luxembourg

The programme focuses on a personal orientation and the resulting development of

a student's life, school and career guidance by bringing together resources inside the

school from the teaching staff, and external impulses from staff specialized in the

artistic, cultural and therapeutic areas.

The aim of the programme is to integrate the experiences of creative work into

everyday life and to favour the best possible development of transversal skills in

students: Self-assurance, self-worth and self-confidence provide them with a

sustainable and increased sense of self-efficiency, ability to take decisions and

flexibility in their actions.

"Life Stage Workshops" integrated in the continuous weekly course work help to

develop social and personal skills during the school year and intensive workshops

on the "Artistic Stage" help to develop formative and artistic skills.

"STOP & GO" has been assessed by Trier University (Germany).

"Young people learn to understand their biographical and biographical body

awareness, in other words, they learn to cope with social and guidance situations

more effectively".

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
